

HEAVY DUTY DRIVER- (with 3 or more licences)

DUTIES

- To safely drive the company vehicles as and when required and as instructed by the Ground Maintenance Coordinator or Airfield Shift Coordinator and implement driving procedures according to company regulation and training;
- To transport air travelling passengers, staff, airfield materials and equipment;
- To operate the company tractor by ensuring of the upkeep of the grassed runway strips and ground within the airport compound;
- To check daily Airfield Section vehicles for serviceability; check gasoline, oil, water and tyres or have filled and wash vehicle as required;
- To conduct routine minor repairs and maintenance on Airfield Section vehicles; parts replacement, oil fill, inter alia, and report malfunction to Asset Development & Maintenance Department;
- To carry out fuel refill on all Airfield Section vehicles before end of shift;
- To ensure the vehicle is in good running conditions and in compliance with all legal and airside requirements;
- To keep mileage record of vehicles in a log book and fill in other forms in relation to his duties;
- To perform messenger duties whenever required;
- To perform any other cognate duties as may be assigned.

Note: Heavy Duty Drivers shall be required to work on a 24hr shift system throughout the year, including declared cyclone days.

- Certificate of Primary Education;
- Valid driving license for (i) Private car and (ii) Bus and (iii) Tractor on P Tyres and (iv) any other vehicle driven on airside;
- Driving license for Goods Vehicle will be an advantage;
- At least 2 years' experience in driving Heavy Duty vehicles.
